

Calling All Interns!

North Country Arts Council Annual Fine Art Show Intern Program

Requirements:

Interns must be at least 16 (sixteen) years of age or at least a high school Junior, no age limit or education requirements.

Internship is limited to 20 individuals who will be selected through an interview process with the NCAC Fine Arts Show Director, Alicia Kohler and Committee.

Internship will begin August 12, 2009 and end when assigned research paper is turned in after the Fine Arts Show (October 4).

Interns will be required to volunteer at the NCAC Summer Arts Festival, August 15, 2009. If this is not possible other volunteer opportunities can be arranged. Interns will be expected to assist in other NCAC projects and attend all NCAC meetings as required.

Four select interns will assist the NCAC Marketing and Publicity Chairperson, George Stadalski, with historical research of the past 60 years of the NCAC Fine Arts Show and North Country Artists' Guild. This research will be used to create a display highlighting the NCAC's history and future goals. These interns will be selected by Mr. Stadalski and Ms. Kohler. This project will count towards the involved intern's research project.

Interns will be introduced to a variety tasks and skills needed to insure the successful planning and completion of an art exhibition. These tasks and skills will include, but are not limited to clerical, measuring, cataloguing, hanging, repair, design, research, and serving as a docent.

Interns will be evaluated on a scale of 1-10. All interns will receive certificates upon completion of this event, however more responsibility will be given to and special notations will be made on certificates where interns have excelled.

A syllabus will be given to each intern at the beginning of the internship.

Other:

The North Country Arts Council and Ms. Kohler will be willing to work with the interns' high school or college to help the intern obtain credit but can not guarantee the credit without approval from their educational institution.
